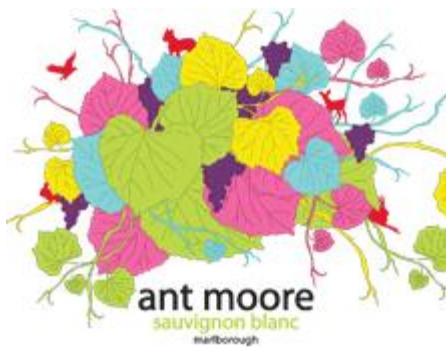

Ant Moore Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc 2010



This wine is typical Marlborough, though a hint of restraint is given due to the lees and barrel work. Tropical fruits are matched with melon, peach and that Marlborough grassiness. A variety of secondary barrel characters emerge on a long clean finish.

Drinking beautifully now, will hold well through to 2013.

Urlar Martinborough Sauvignon Blanc 2010



The Urlar Sauvignon Blanc delivers zesty gooseberry, grapefruit, and lime flavours with a hint of passionfruit. While it remains a distinctively New Zealand sauvignon blanc the palate is full with great weight and length, courtesy of some partial oak ferment and skilled winemaking.

Drink Now-early 2013. CERTIFIED ORGANIC.

Wither Hills 'Rarangi' Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc 2010



This is a Wither Hills single vineyard Sauvignon Blanc well worth singling out. Stunning herbal nose mingles with gooseberry, citrus and other ripe fruits. A dry mineral palate full of ripe melon, tropical fruit layers, with intensity and texture is supported by an elegant and refined acidity.

Yealands Reserve Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc 2009



Only made in good years, the Yealands Reserve is the pinnacle of the Yealands Range. Aromas of dried thyme, honey and sweet pea are underpinned by hints of nut, savoury notes and a long mineral finish.

Drink now through 2012. Match with spicy dishes.

Saint Clair Block 2 Swamp Block Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc 2010



The Swamp Block Sauvignon Blanc displays an aroma of intensely lifted notes of blackcurrant and nettles, with pungent tropical aromas of passionfruit and guava. This is an intense Sauvignon Blanc with an incredible concentration of flavours and palate weight. Passionfruit, grapefruit and citrus flavours dominate the palate with an underlying mineral and nettle note and a rich round finish. Drinking perfectly now and through to 2012.
