## Goldwater Marlborough Chardonnay 2010



This wine shows an excellent balance of fruit expression and winemaker influence. Approximately 75% of the wine goes through malolactic in order to soften and enrich the palate. 60% of the wine is then aged in new French oak barriques for eleven months, with the remaining 40% going into stainless steel to retain fruit intensity. The aromas and flavours are packed with peaches, apricots, limes and subtle spice. The palate is rich, vibrant, and refreshing. Drink now to 2013+

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## Craggy Range Te Muna Martinborough Sauvignon Blanc 2010



Pale greenish straw in colour. Rich aromatics of fresh lime juice, elderflower, lemongrass, grilled citrus and ripe nectarine. Complex and intriguing. The palate is concentrated and dense, yet retains remarkable linearity and focus. Zesty citrus, stonefruit, herb and floral flavours fill the mouth, a fine chalky mineral texture tightens and focuses the finish. At it's best within 3 years of vintage.

The 2010 Tupari Sauvignon Blanc displays a nose of white peach and passionfruit, with a hint citrus and orange zest. The palate is of concentrated white peach and citrus flavours and a distinct mineral quality. The long and creamy palate finishes with a refreshing acidity. Drink now through 2012.

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## Black Estate Waipara Riesling 2010



The Black Estate Riesling shows a crisp and fresh bouquet of cool river stones. Emerging nectarine, white peach, mandarin and lime draw you into the glass where rich stone fruits coat dense and textural phenolics. The wine advances giving great length by the salivating acidity.

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## Coopers Creek 'Dillons Point' Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc 2010



The Coopers Creek Select Vineyard Dillons Point shows a nose of concentrated passionfruit and nectarine along with herbal nuances and a touch of sweat for complexity. The wine is surprisingly full bodied for a Sauvignon Blanc. It retains the typical racy acidity of the variety, but also has mid palate richness and loads of sweet fruit on the finish.
