Urlar Martinborough Pinot Gris 2009



The Urlar Pinot Gris is an opulent dry styled wine with aromas of sweet pear, honeysuckle and stonefruit overlaying a generous mouthfeel of great weight and depth. The creamy texture on the palate from the lees stirring provides the backbone to a long and lingering finish. An elegant wine with a beautiful balance - One of our favourite Pinot Gris.

Drink now through 2013. Match with pork dishes, especially a slow roasted pork belly or asian cuisine that is lightly spiced.

The Staete Landt Chardonnay achieves the perfect balance - full and round yet stylish, great texture and length, with great acidity and elegant oak integration. A hint of summer stone fruit on the nose, white peaches & cream, hazelnuts on the palate with a mineral aftertaste that lingers on. A truly great wine with a strong personality and a European elegance, showing the unique cool climate Marlborough vibrance.

This wine has aromatics reminiscent of a fruit cocktail full of white pear, passionfruit and melon. On the palate this is duplicated with lovely rich flavours, a textured mid palate and an off-dry finish.

Spy Valley Envoy Marlborough Gewurztraminer 2007



The nose of the Spy Valley Envoy gives aromas of manuka honey, ripe peach and an underlying rose petal signature. The palate is generous and rich, following the nose with a similar flavour profile. The richness is balanced with the underlying phenolic structure. Beautifully balanced and still looking very fresh after 4 years in the bottle.

Drink Now - early 2013.

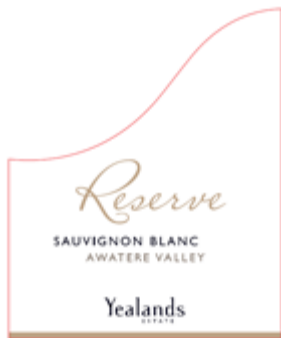

Yealands Reserve Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc 2009



Only made in good years, the Yealands Reserve is the pinnacle of the Yealands Range. Aromas of dried thyme, honey and sweet pea are underpinned by hints of nut, savoury notes and a long mineral finish.

Drink now through 2012. Match with spicy dishes.

Black Estate Waipara Chardonnay 2010



The Black Estate Chardonnay reveals a complex nose of grapefruit, nectarine, white peach, walnut, vanilla, and crushed oyster shell. The pallet is dense and expansive, transparent of the clay soils from which it originates. A powerful wine with salivating mineral persistence.

Taut on release, this wine will benefit from another 1-2 years in the bottle and cellar successfully to 2016+.
