Urlar Martinborough Pinot Noir 2009



The Urlar Pinot Noir was matured in 25% new French oak barriques and fined using natural products. The 2009 vintage delivers an enticing nose of ripe red fruits and dark chocolate which combine with flavours of sweet dark plums intermingled with savoury notes and exotic spices. This wine is elegant and refined with a seamless rich texture through the palate. Drink Now-2014+. CERTIFIED ORGANIC and made using Biodynamic principles.

Wild Rock Cupids Arrow Central Otago Pinot Noir 2009

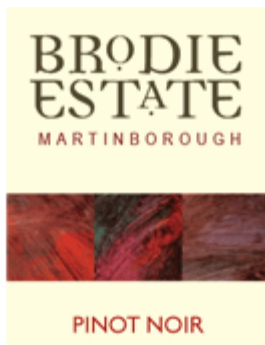


Medium blackish-red in colour. The vibrant aromas are of red berries, cranberry and floral notes with a background of savoury dried herbs and wild thyme. The palate is complex and elegant with raspberry, boysenberry and cherry fruit characters with a rich savoury undertone. Fine sandy tannins and supporting acidity draw the wine into a long, bright finish. Cellar for up to 5 years from vintage



Your Tasting Notes:

Brodie Estate Martinborough Pinot Noir 2008



The 2008 vintage produced well ripened fruit. The bunches of small berries were handpicked and carefully macerated followed by ageing for 10 months in a selection of barrels. This is a beautifully integrated wine with silky tannins. Violets and cherries on the nose followed by rich mouth-filling dark fruits with hints of vanilla and chocolate producing a well balanced, rich and lively Pinot Noir. Drinking beautifully now, it will continue to develop in the bottle through to 2014+

Yealands Estate Marlborough Pinot Noir 2009



Made from low-yielding Awatere Valley vines, and a lovely expression of Marlborough Pinot Noir. The Yealands Estate Pinot Noir shows lifted aromas of violets, red berries and spice. The palate is refined with plum notes and complemented by silky tannins and a long savoury finish.

Drink now through to late 2013.



Your Tasting Notes:

Waitiri Creek 'Drummer' Central Otago Pinot Noir 2009



Rich on the nose, the wine displays classical raspberry and cherry notes. The palate displays bramble characters, and some sweet dark fruits supported by oak and an integrated tannin structure.

Drink now-2013.

Jackson Estate Vintage Widow Marlborough Pinot Noir 2009



The colour of this 2009 vintage is dark and vibrant. The wine has a black pepper nose and also shows small dark berry aromas with spicy undertones. The palate is rich and medium-bodied with fine soft tannins. The tannins give structure to the good mid-palate and long finish.

Cellar Potential 5 – 10 years.
