Mission Estate Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc 2010



The bouquet has intense lime, passionfruit and blackcurrant bud aromas. In the mouth the wine has good weight and is refined with an integrated mid-palate. The intense mid-palate leads to a dry, persistent clean finish. The style is complex with character and minerality.

Drink now through to 2013.

Waihopai Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc 2010



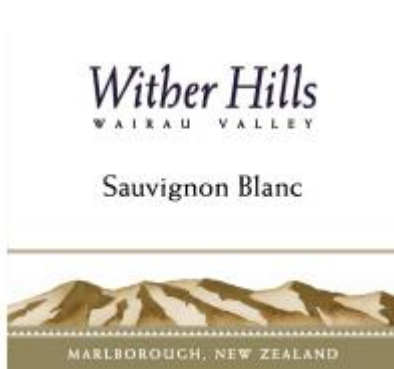
The nose of Waihopai displays lemon and lime citrus, fresh green herbs and lifted aromas of green capsicum. The palate is crisp citrus with hints of stone fruits. Finishing with fresh herbal overtones and a fine minerality. The individual parcels that were blended give this wine a rich layered complexity and textured mouthfeel.

Match with summer salads. Drink now-late 2012.

Wither Hills Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc 2011



Supple aromatic intensity of kaffir lime, brambly tomato leaf, clementine, sweet Meyer lemon, fennel leaf, with underlying gooseberry and red capsicum held with tropical guava and slight tease of 'sweat' This fills your senses and melds with salty seamlessness, textural acidity, stalky herbaceousness and fruit weight to deliver another remarkable Wither Hills 'Wairau Valley' Sauvignon Blanc

Drink now through 2013.

Wither Hills Two Tracks Sauvignon Blanc 2010 is everything you want from a Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc. Bright zingy fresh aromas of gooseberry, dried herb, citrus & tomato leaf characters lead into a palate of sweet capsicum balanced with fresh citrus lime flavours and a touch of supple tropical guava to finish.

Coopers Creek 'Dillons Point' Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc 2010



The Coopers Creek Select Vineyard Dillons Point shows a nose of concentrated passionfruit and nectarine along with herbal nuances and a touch of sweat for complexity. The wine is surprisingly full bodied for a Sauvignon Blanc. It retains the typical racy acidity of the variety, but also has mid palate richness and loads of sweet fruit on the finish. Drink Now-early 2013.

Martinborough Vineyards Sauvignon Blanc 2010



Typically, the Martinborough Vineyards Sauvignon Blanc exhibits perfumed aromas of passionfruit and guava with tropical and vanilla notes on the nose. On the palate the ripe fruit character is beautifully balanced against creamy notes from the barrel fermentation portion creating a harmonious and balanced wine with great length and texture.
